

“If you don’t attend, please tell us why:”


- **18-24:** “Didn't know what class to go to, no class for my age group”


“Opening assembly was important for me.”

“ I learn things in Sunday School that help my later at home/school/ work.”






“Sunday School is important for children.”


“Sunday School is important for all ages.”


“Sunday School at 10:00am on Sunday works well for my family.”


“ I prefer a Sunday School class that encourages discussion.”


“ I prefer a Sunday School class where I basically listen and a teacher lectures.”


“ I prefer to be in a Sunday School class along with others close to my age.”

“ I prefer to be in a Sunday School class that studies ‘through the Bible’ in an orderly fashion.”






# Sunday School

### “Comments about my answers on Sunday School:”

- Sunday School class members share a bond based on being together and sharing joys and sorrows.
- The opening of Sunday School takes time away from study/if you are doing a video with discussion there is little time to get through video and then discuss
- I have always enjoyed Sunday School, whether it is lecture, videos, or discussions.
- I think each class should choose what curriculum works best for them
- Sunday School is important to young children. It is good training to start early in life to learn about God. This may be the only time some children learn about Jesus.
- (1) Studying the Bible is important for all ages - not sure if Sunday School continues to be the avenue to do this. For kids - having strong children's church & Bible options. (2) I am not a fan of Bible studies using a video. I like the class to study Bible and have discussion.
- If we go back to Sunday School as it was for adults, I do not see a point.
- SS 9:00am and worship at 10 would be even better! Not a fan of videos
- We study the Bible, get to visit with people our age, keep up with people in community.

- Children's material is designed for larger groups than what we have.





“I enjoyed my class.”




“I considered my classmates as friends.”
