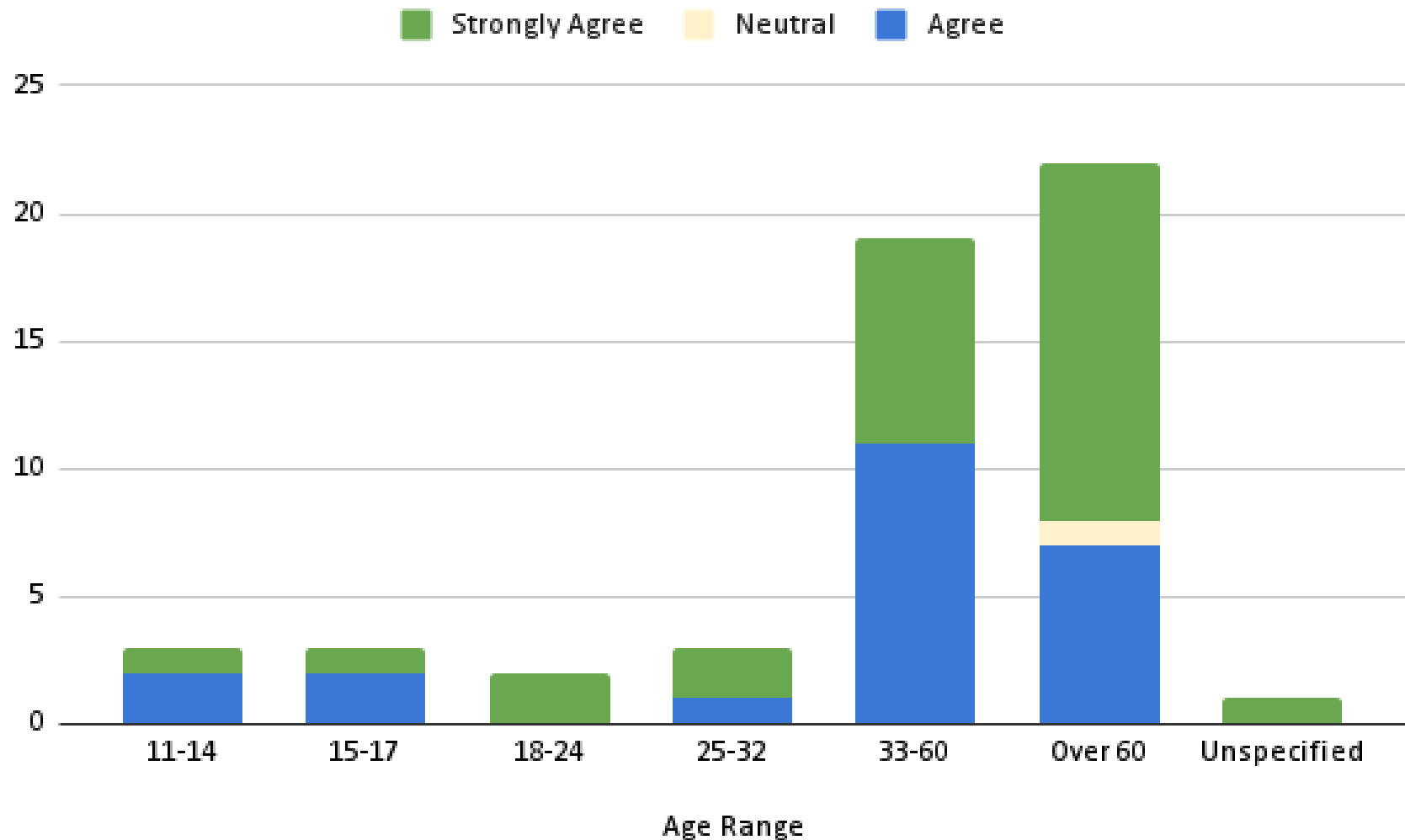

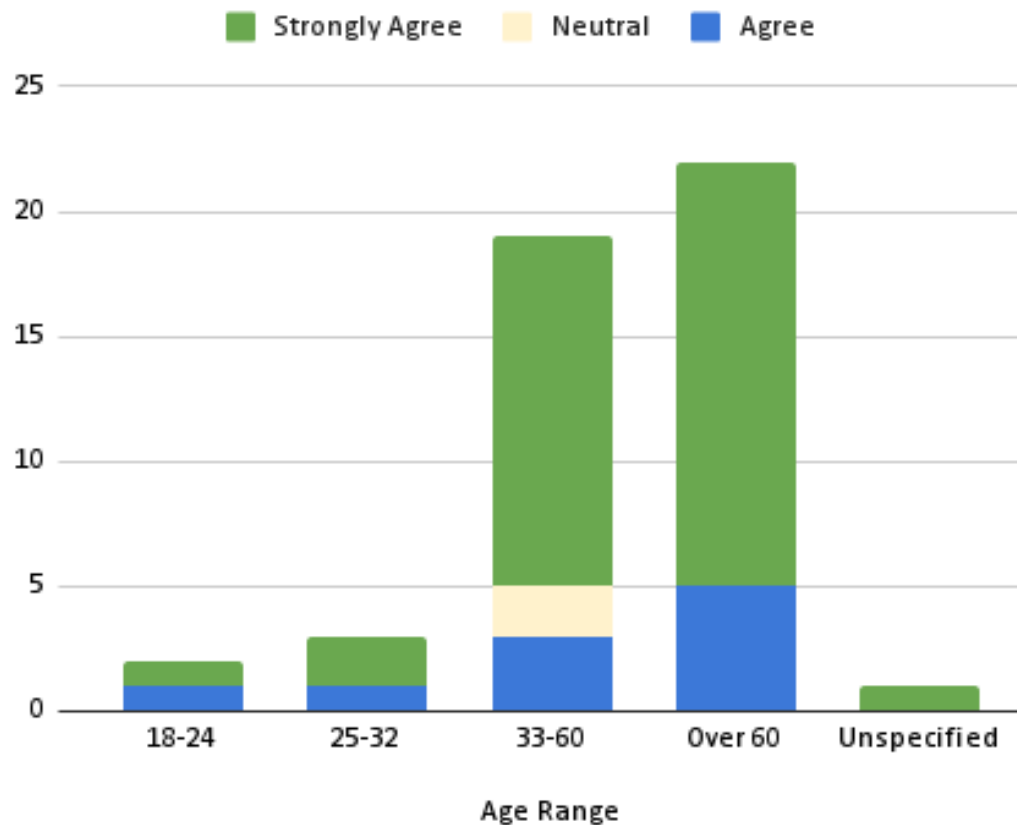

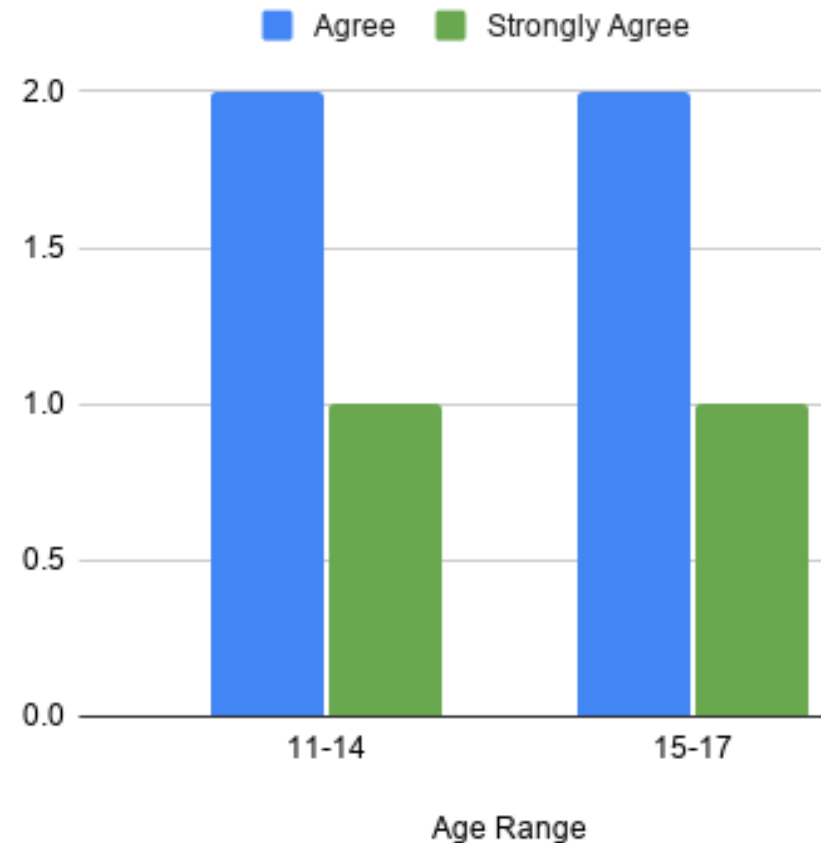

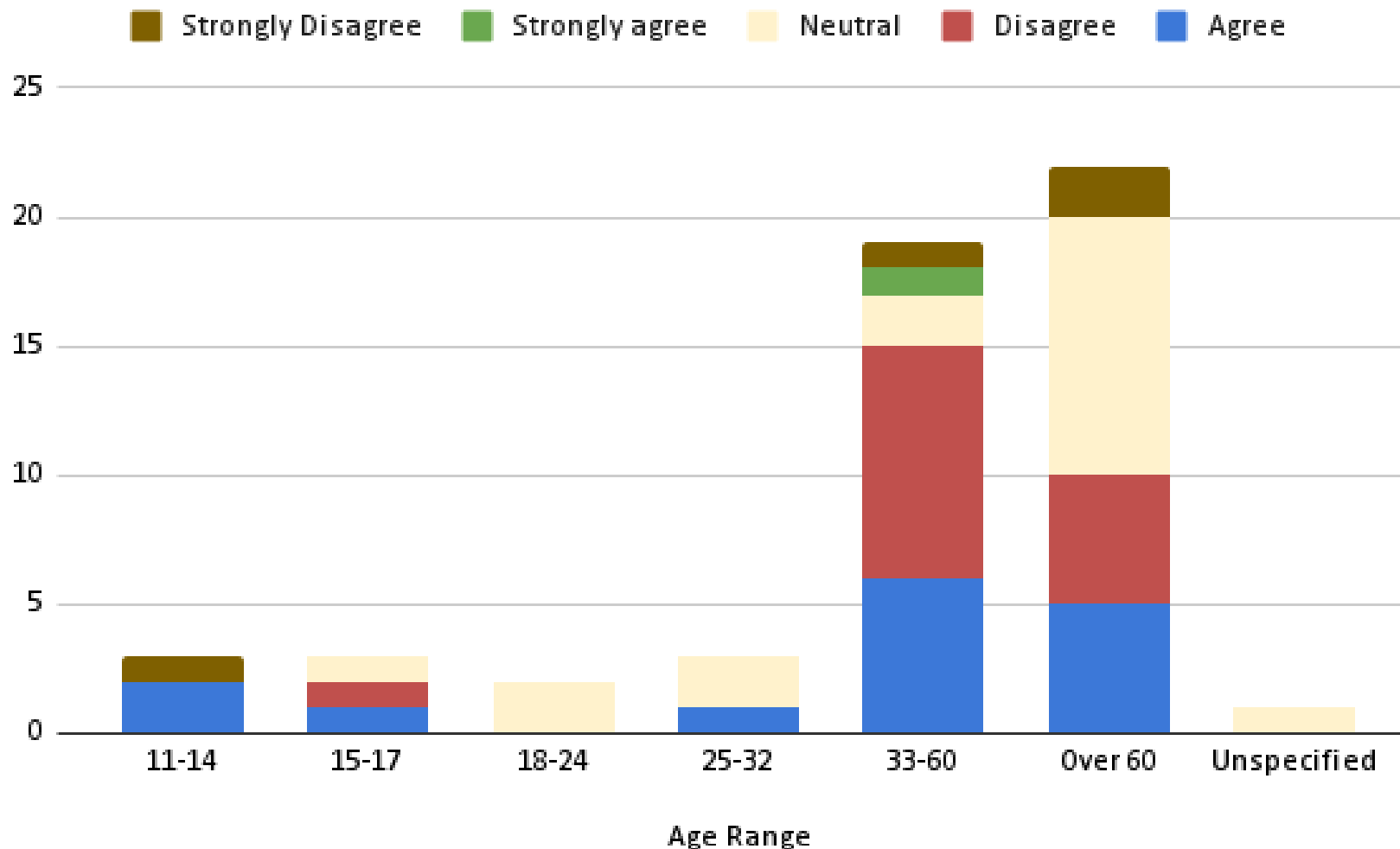
## “Comments on my answers for "worship before COVID happened:”

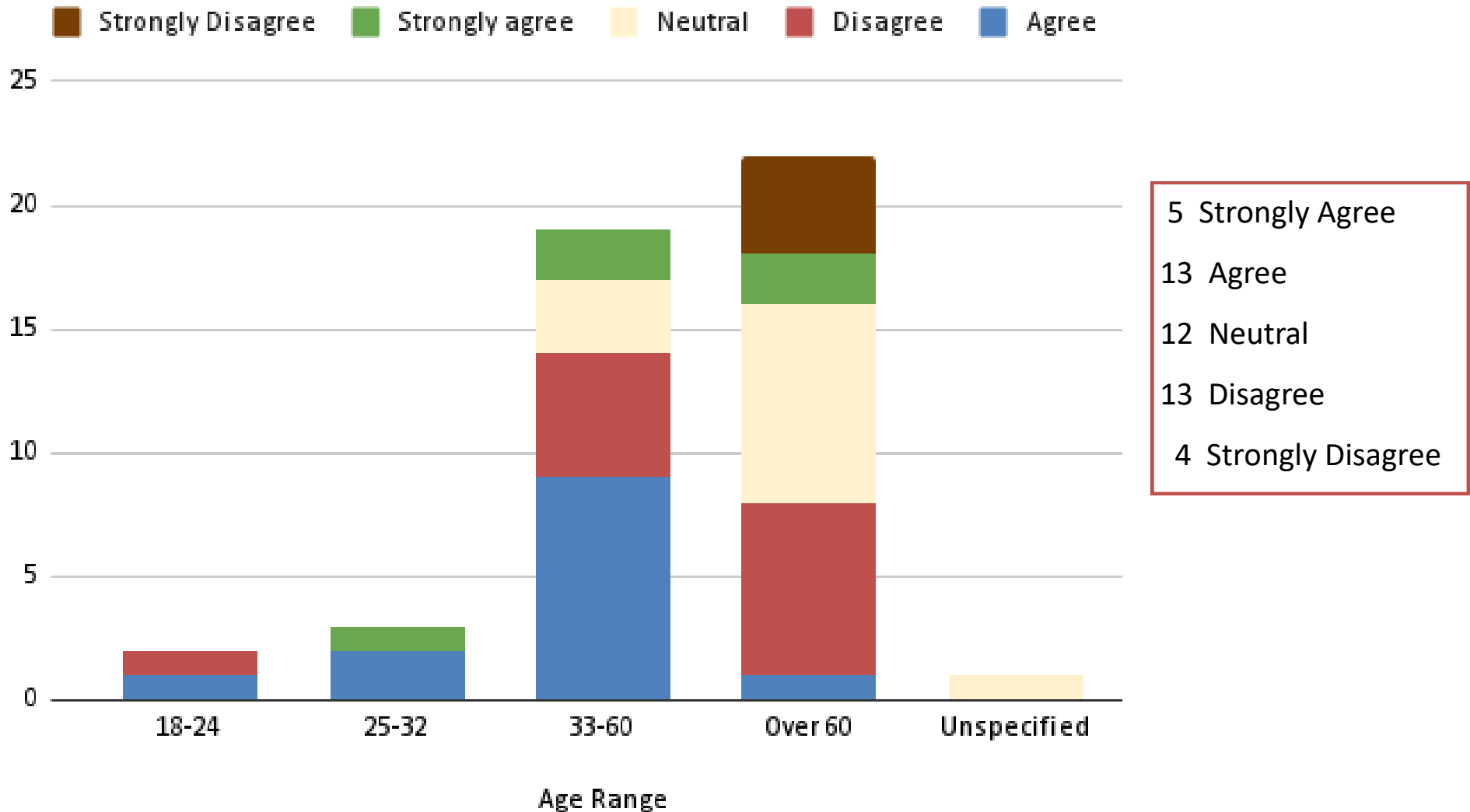

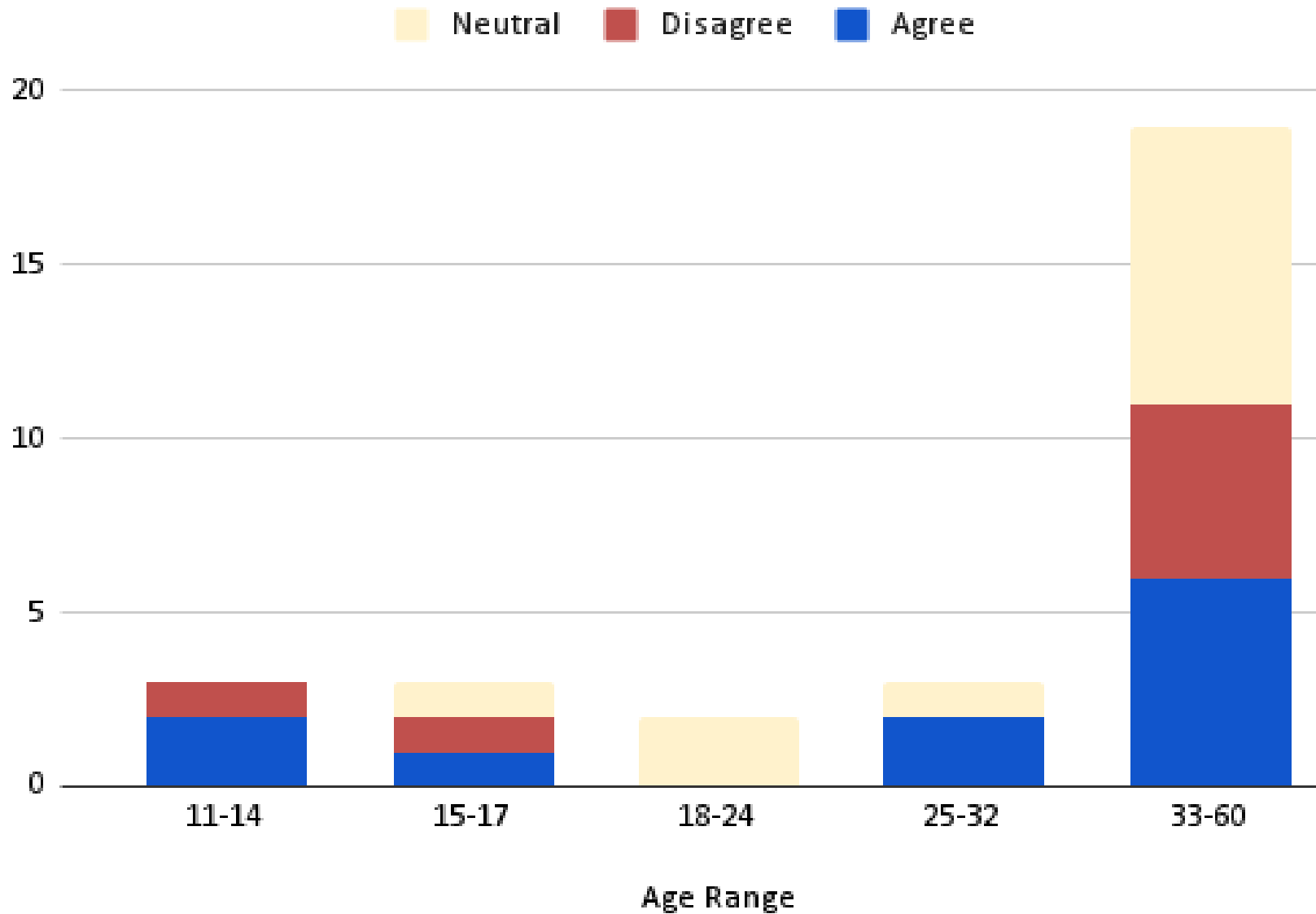
“I would prefer an earlier time for worship.”

## “Comments on my answers for "worship in the future:”

- 18-24** • I really enjoy hymns, but occasional contemporary worship would also be enjoyable. I also like 10:00 as a start time.
  
- 25-32** • Love worship at 10am
  
- 33-60** • Have enjoyed worship being at 10 am but 9 am is early for Sunday School/ if we keep worship at 10 then I would prefer Sunday School to follow church
  - Choir music selection great
  - 10:00am is what I prefer for worship
  - Congregational singing choices: Even enjoy more than 1 hymn per service. Choir choices: I miss the choir and the variety of music they shared each week.
  
- Over 60** • choir: They do great - what THEY choose!
  - Love using some of the old hymns but really love the new contemporary Christian music and love the music that Beth chose in the past for the choir. I love the 10:00 am morning worship hour. Even if the service is extended to from 10:00 - 11:30 am - I would
  - 10:00am is good. Leave (the music) up to the choir; just bring them back!
  - Although I like the music like it was I am flexible.

**“If you have other ideas for worship or music during worship when we return, please tell us:**

- 33-60**
- I love the choir and song selections.
  - sing contemporary songs like you hear on radio along with hymns
  - Prayer concerns and praises are very important however not to repeat each.
  - We need to mix up our congregational singing & include praise songs. Can do both sing praise song & hymn. I worry that music doesn't incorporate current Christian music - it will be harder to attract and keep young people & young families. We can get musimusic license and use contemporary music - sing with online videos with artist singing their songs. We sing along with Michael W. Smith, Chris Tomlin, Newsboys, Mercy Me, etc. Have words on screen to sing along with the artist.

### **Over 60**

- Would not get there as often possibly if service was earlier.
- We need the choir back!
- Keep everything about the same
- i am not a big fan of the "new" recorded music.
