Canned vegetables (potatoes, carrots, mixed vegetables, beans)	

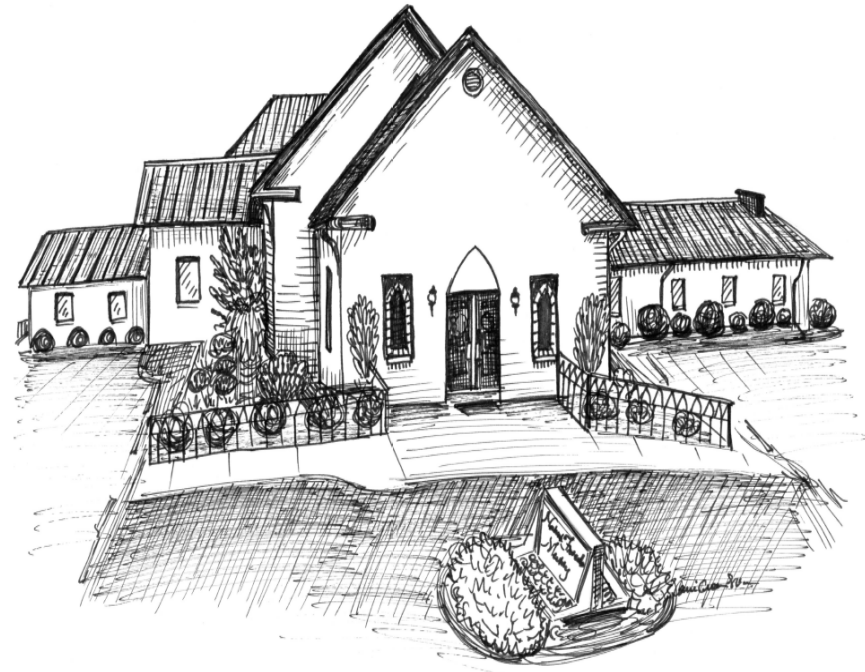
Spirit of Nahunta 2026 Silent Auction
