Spirit of Nahunta 2026 Silent Auction

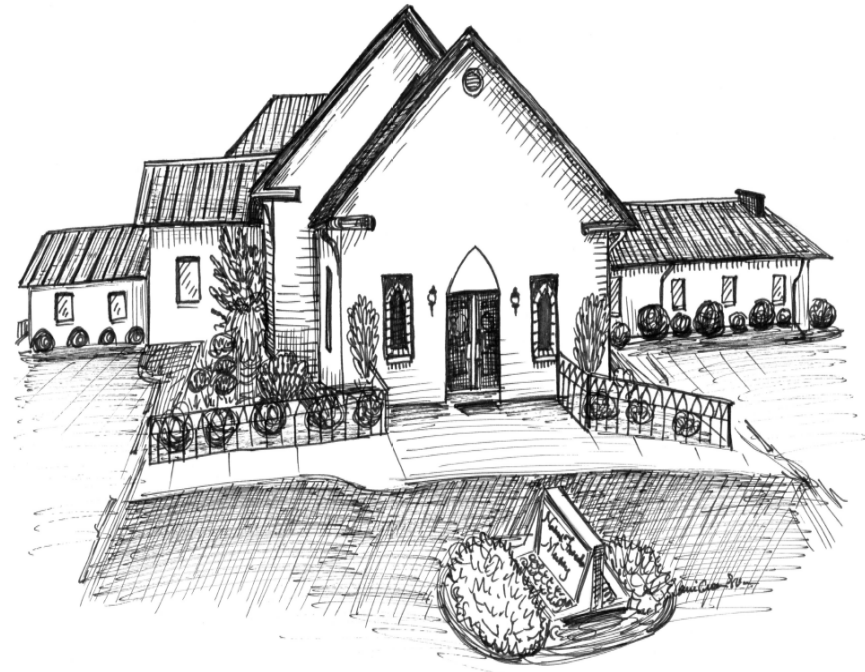
